Duties and Responsibilities:

- Teach courses of Spanish in the Middle School (gr 6-8) and Upper School (gr 9-12)
- Implement the Spanish curriculum
- Collaborate with other members of the World Language Department and the entire faculty to align curriculum and ensure the highest standards of education are being met
- Attend faculty meetings as needed
- Perform duties as assigned by Department Chair, Division Directors, or Head of School
- Fulfill all other faculty responsibilities that may occur outside the school day, including writing reports and planning
