Responsibilities:

- Develops and teaches the Center's curriculum to include: an entrepreneurship course; the summer practicum where students work with a local business; a once a week follow-up communications course in which students analyze and write up their center experience.
- Teaches an introduction to business course open to sophomores, juniors, and seniors.
- Works with the Upper School Director and Assistant Head of Academic Affairs to develop the criteria required for student selection, participation, and assessment.
- Seeks and cultivates mentors in the business community and interfaces with entrepreneurs to seek their participation as summer mentors to Center students.
- Sells the program to prospective students.
- Identifies ways for students in the Center to take part in the Ohio DECA competitions and challenges.
- Serves as the spokesperson for the program with donors.
- Arranges for the Center's annual colloquium for students to share their work.
