



GRADES K-8 PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHER

THE POSITION: Birchwood School of Hawken is actively seeking a part-time Physical Education teacher in grades K-8 for the 2021-22 school year.

The essential duties/responsibilities of this position include, but are not limited to, the following:

Teach Physical Education classes, students in Kindergarten-8th grade.

- Responsible for creating and implementing games and activities related to exercise, traditional and non-traditional sports.
